Scholarship Aim	The Donald Tugby for Excellence in Equine Clinical Practice was established in 2012. Dr Tugby taught anthropology at The University of Queensland from 1958 to 1986 and for part of that time, a social science course at the then Gatton College. Dr Tugby often visited the University's Pinjarra Hills farm. He was a competitive horse rider, a BHS Riding Instructor, and bred Anglo-Arab Horses.
