



**ALLAN TINDALL SCHOLARSHIP IN ANIMAL PRODUCTION AND LIVESTOCK HEALTH  
2020**

<b>Scholarship Aim</b>	The purpose of the Scholarship is to financially assist undergraduate veterinary science students to undertake practical educational placements where their skills in livestock health and production, veterinary pathology or veterinary public health and biosecurity will be used and extended.
<b>Scholarship Value and Duration</b>	<p>The number of each Scholarship will be determined annually by the Associate Dean on the recommendation of the Head in consultation with the selection committee</p> <p>The minimum annual combined scholarship value will be \$10,000 with the value for each scholarship recipient to be determined by the Associate Dean on the recommendation of the Head in consultation with the selection committee.</p>
<b>Eligibility Criteria</b>	<p>An applicant is eligible for the Scholarship if the applicant –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) submits an application to the Head, by the closing date for applications; and</li><li>(b) is a domestic student within the meaning of the Fee Rules; and</li><li>(c) is enrolled full-time in the third year of the Approved Program; and</li><li>(d) intends to undertake the external practical placement during the fourth or fifth year of the Approved Program.</li></ul>
<b>Selection Process</b>	<p>The Scholarship is awarded to the applicant(s) showing greatest merit as demonstrated by -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) academic performance in the Approved Program to date in the subject areas of livestock husbandry, production, health and welfare, pathology and infectious diseases, veterinary public health and biosecurity; and</li><li>(b) financial need; and</li><li>(c) personal qualities; and</li><li>(d) a proposal which outlines the way in which the practical placement will improve the student's skills in rural veterinary services (private or government practice) or related agribusinesses; and</li><li>(e) any other evidence which may be deemed relevant to the applicant's future success in the veterinary profession</li></ul> <p>Preference will be given to students who intend to work in a rural location after the completion of the Approved Program.</p>
<b>Application Process</b>	<p>Please complete all sections of the application form including signatures and ensure that supporting documentation is attached. Completed submissions are to be emailed to <a href="mailto:vet@enquire.uq.edu.au">vet@enquire.uq.edu.au</a> by <b>4:00pm 31 August 2019</b>. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.</p>
