Scholarship Aim	Established in 1983 by a gift of \$3 000 from Mr and Mrs D. H. Kemp in memory of their son, Duncan Kemp, first year student in the Faculty of Veterinary Science at the time of his death in June 1982.
Scholarship Value and Duration	Money to the value of at least \$650
Eligibility Criteria	<p>An applicant is eligible for the award of the Scholarship if, the applicant –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • is entering Year V of the Bachelor of Veterinary Science or Bachelor of Veterinary Science (Honours) • presents evidence acceptable to the Head of having lived and worked on an animal-based farm or property; and • submits an application for the prize by the closing date for application.
Selection Process	<p>The Scholarship is awarded to the applicant –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • who presents evidence acceptable to the Head of having lived and worked on an animal-based farm or property; and • Achieves the combined highest mark in VETS4034 and VETS4035 in the previous year.
Application Process	<p>Please complete all sections of the application form including signatures and ensure that supporting documentation is attached. Completed submissions are to be emailed to c.girvin.uq.edu.au by 5:00pm (AEST) 13 March 2026. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.</p> <p>The Selection Committee may decide to interview short-listed applicants, and their determination will be considered final; no further communication will be entered into. All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their application.</p>
